

# Uninstalling ADM

1. Open Control Panel and select "Programs and Features" for Windows 7 (and up) or "Add or Remove Programs" for earlier versions of Windows:

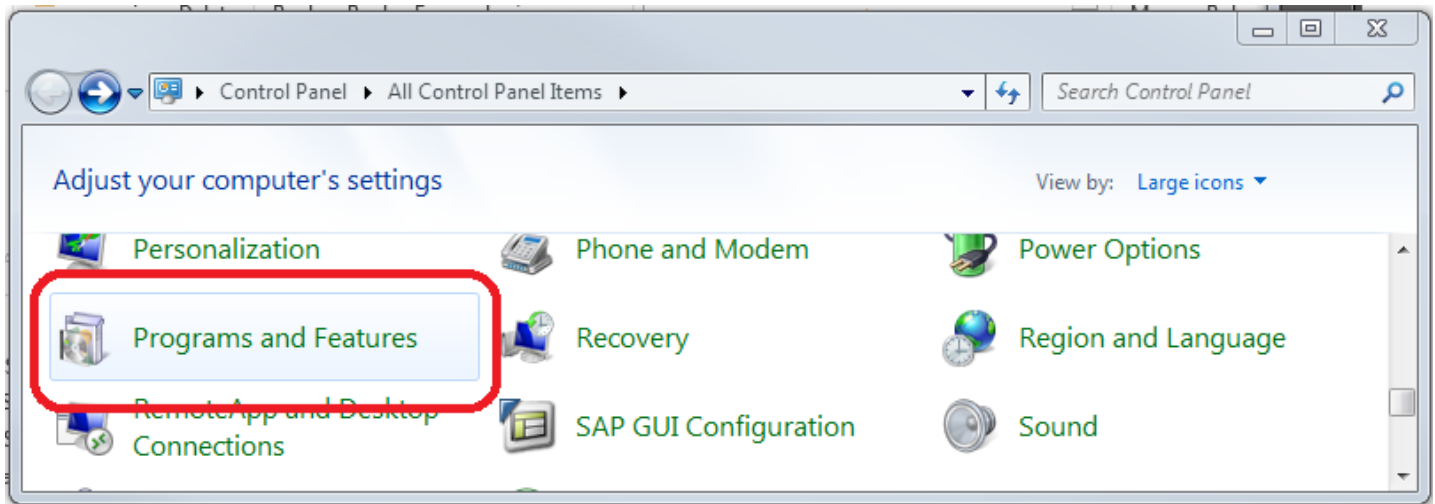


Figure 1 Control Panel in Windows 7 and up

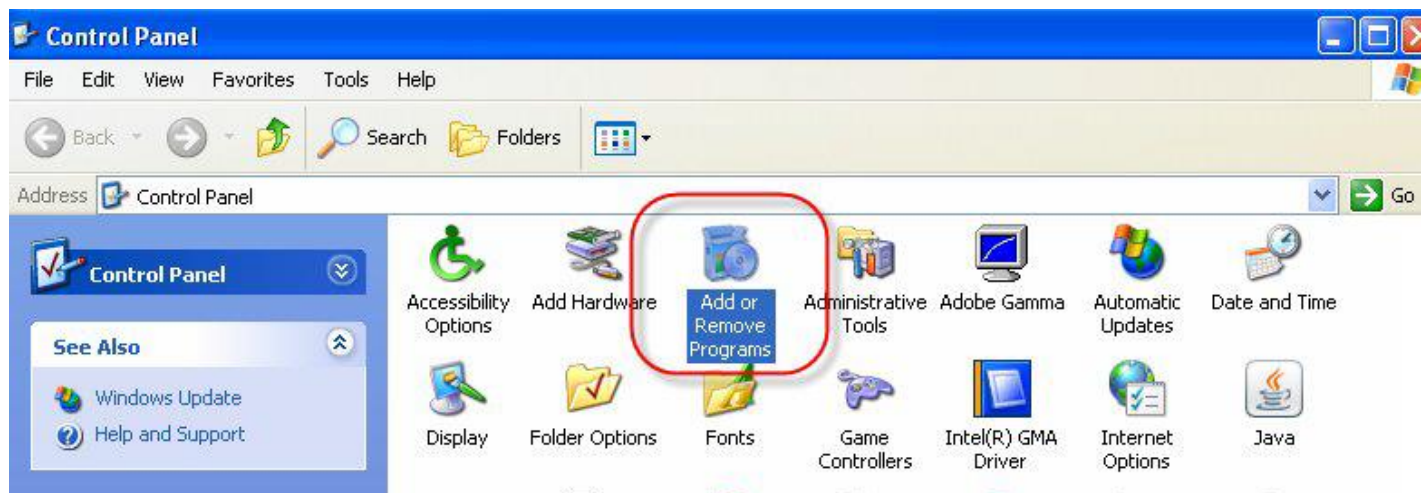


Figure 2 Control Panel in prior versions of Windows

2. Select/Highlight ADM from the list and click on the "Remove" button

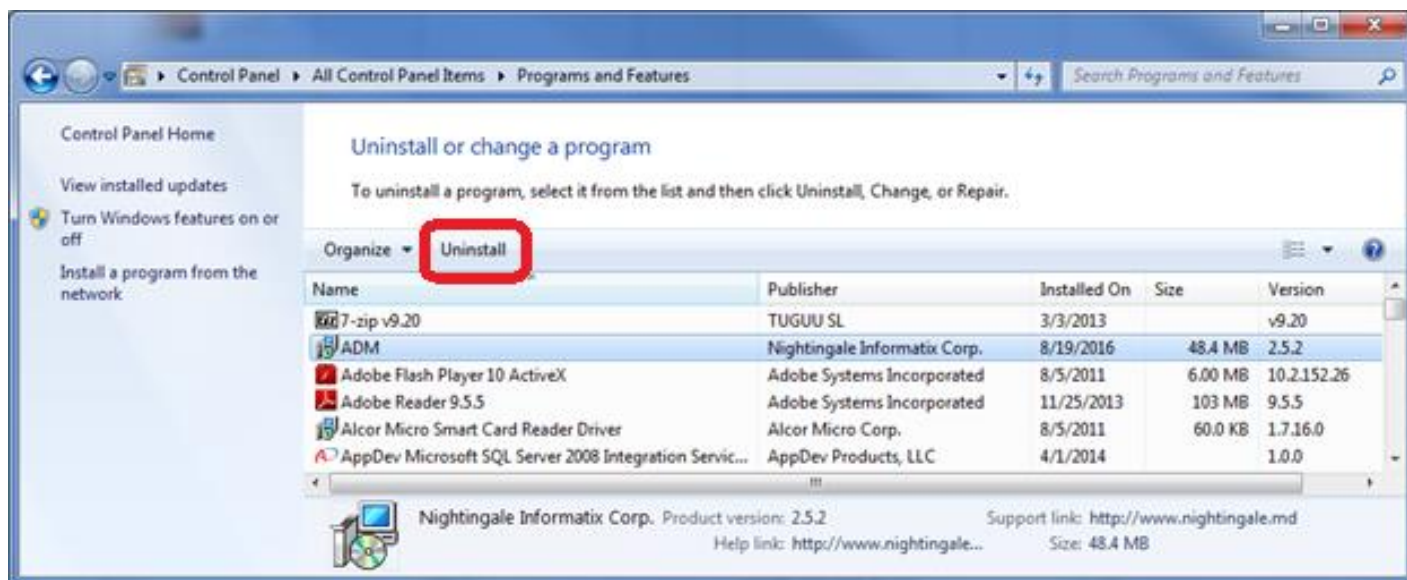


Figure 3 Programs and Features in Windows 7 and up

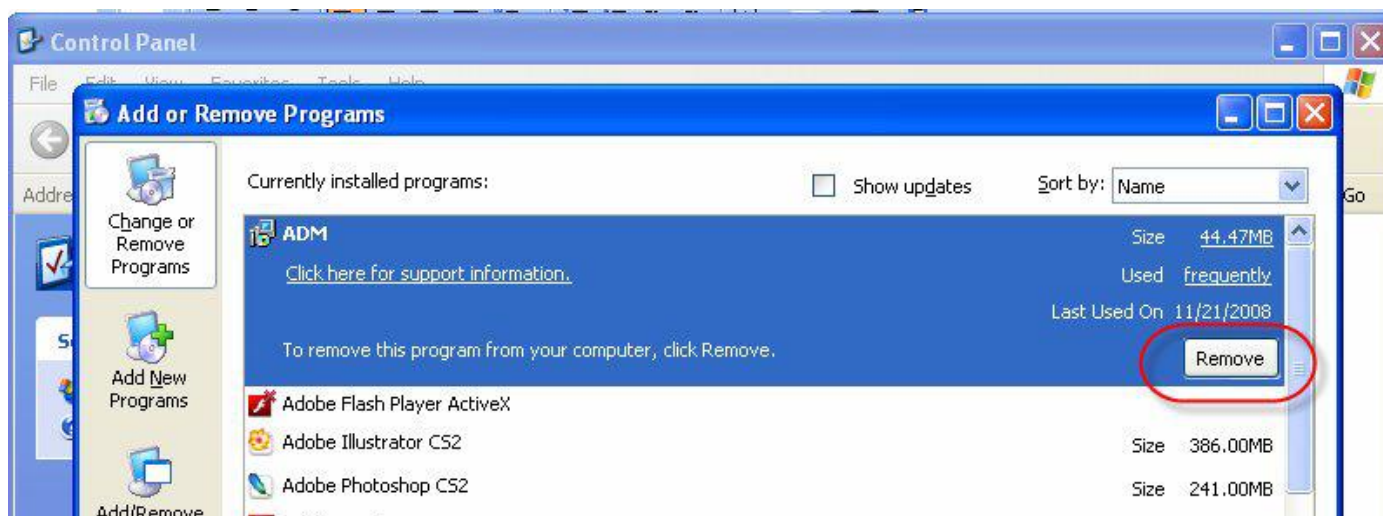
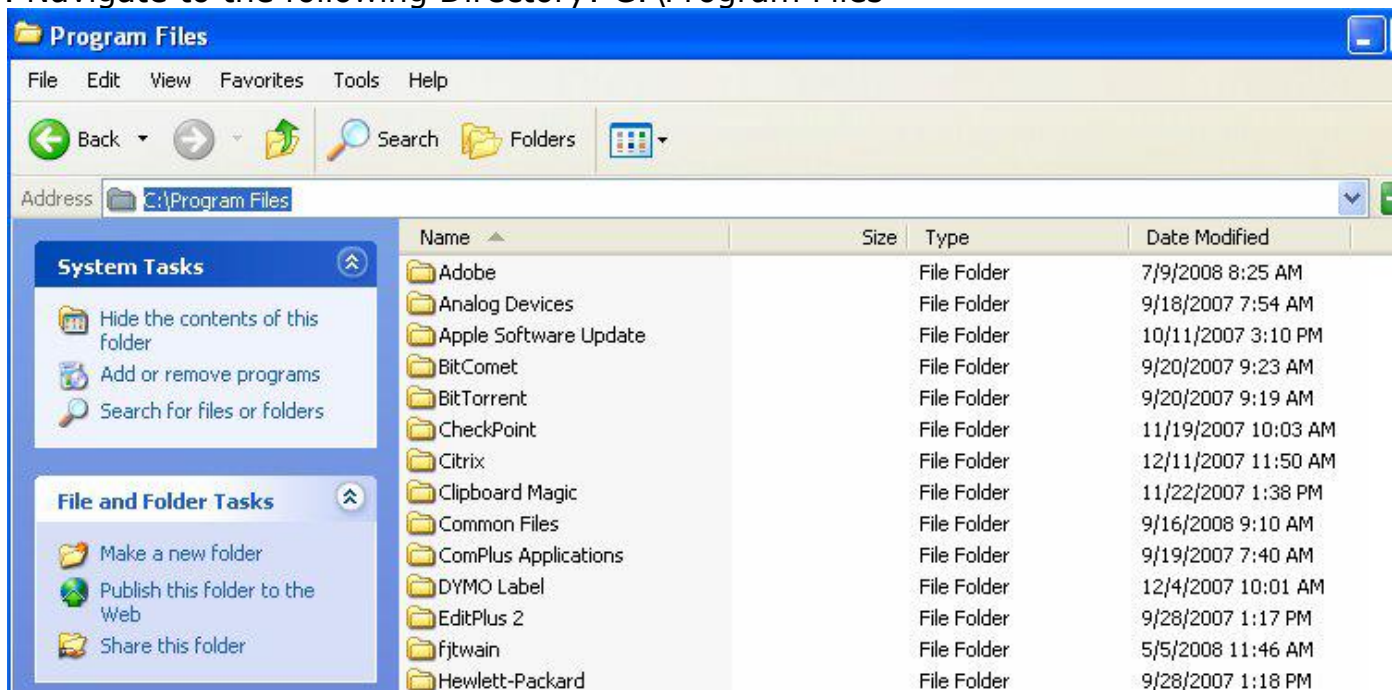


Figure 4 Add or Remove Programs in prior versions of Windows

3. Once ADM has been successfully removed from Control Panel, Open "My Computer"

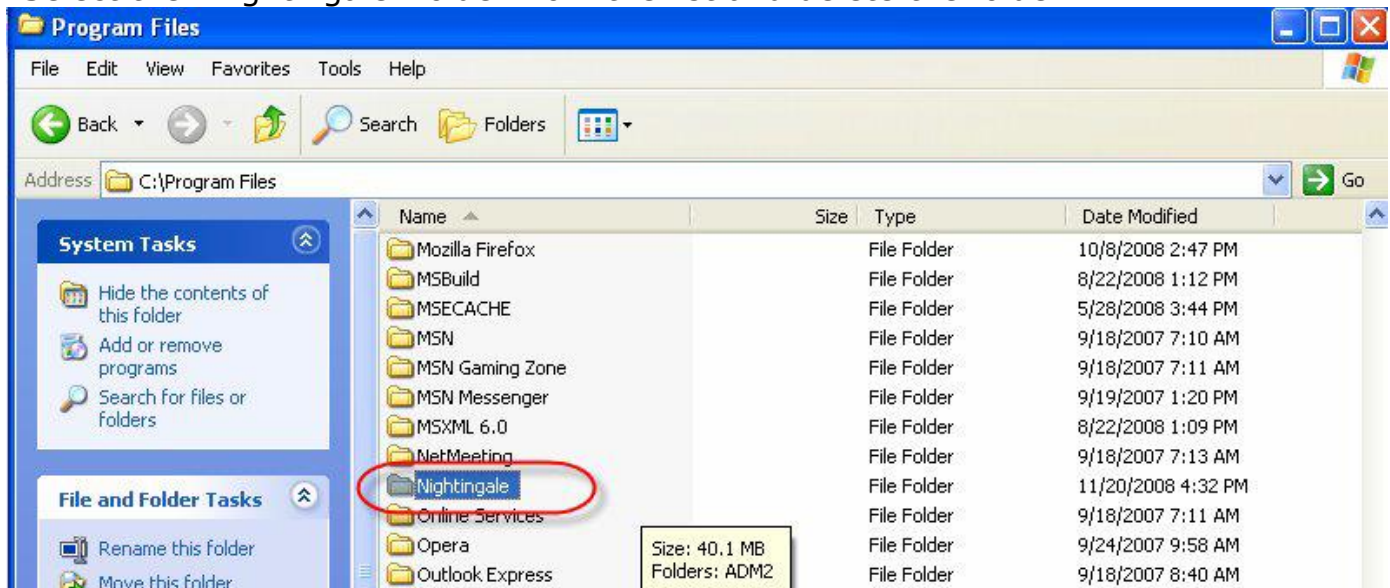


4. Navigate to the following Directory: C:\Program Files

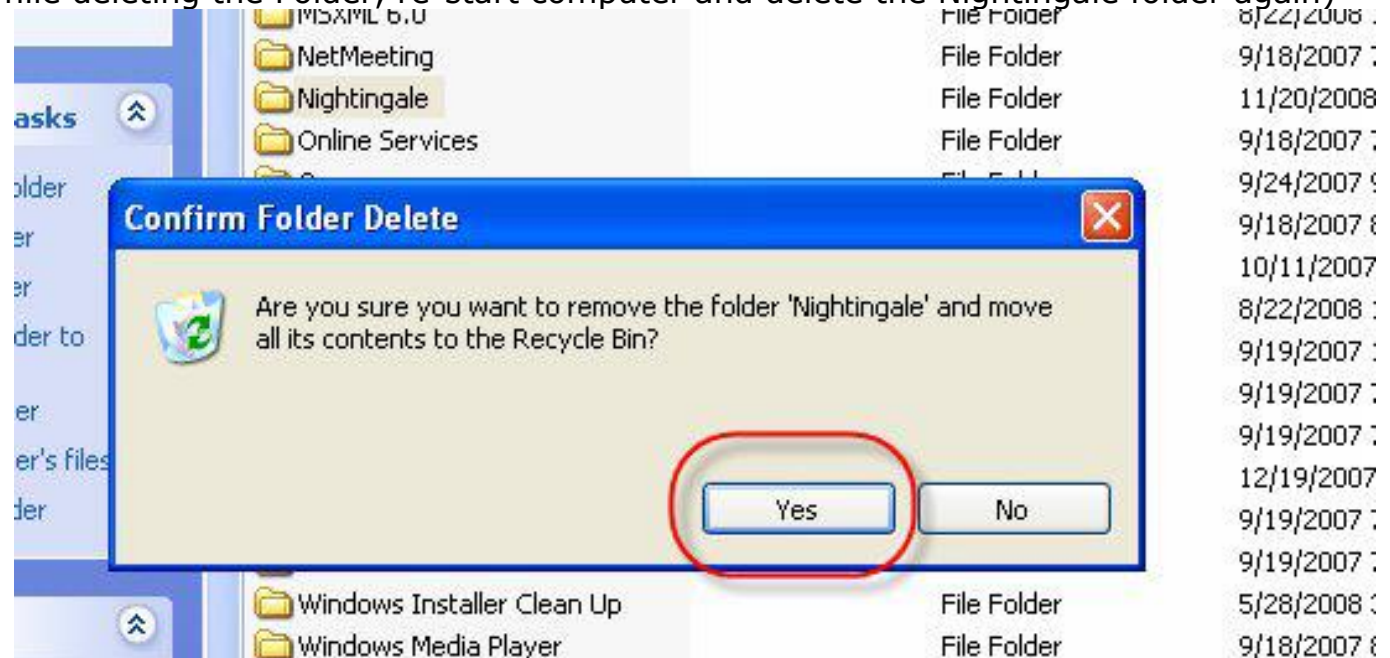




5. Select the "Nightingale" folder from the list and delete the folder
